8:30 – 9:25 am **Termite Baiting: The Fascinating Science of Termites and the Baiting Industry, Tyler Cooper, Dow AgroSciences**

Termites are fascinating insects that cause millions of dollars of damage in our country. We have learned a great deal about the habits of different termite colonies. Proper baiting and applications are essential for long term control. Tyler will address how effective control can be achieved by using scientific know-how.
